13. DISSOLUTION:-

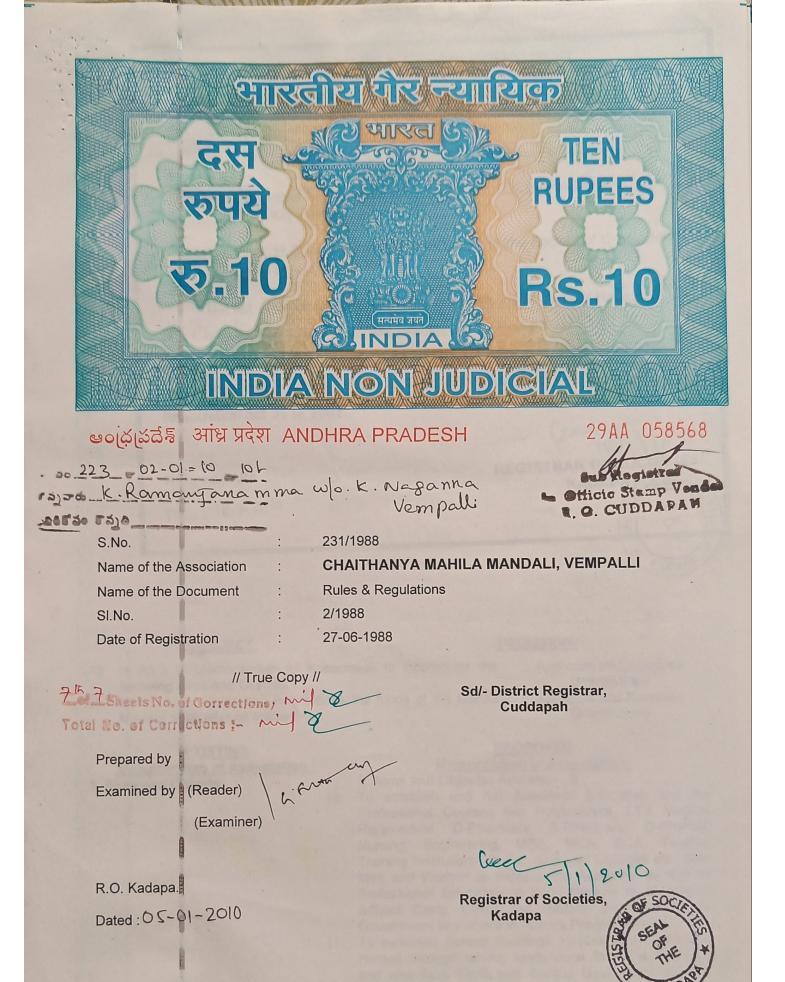

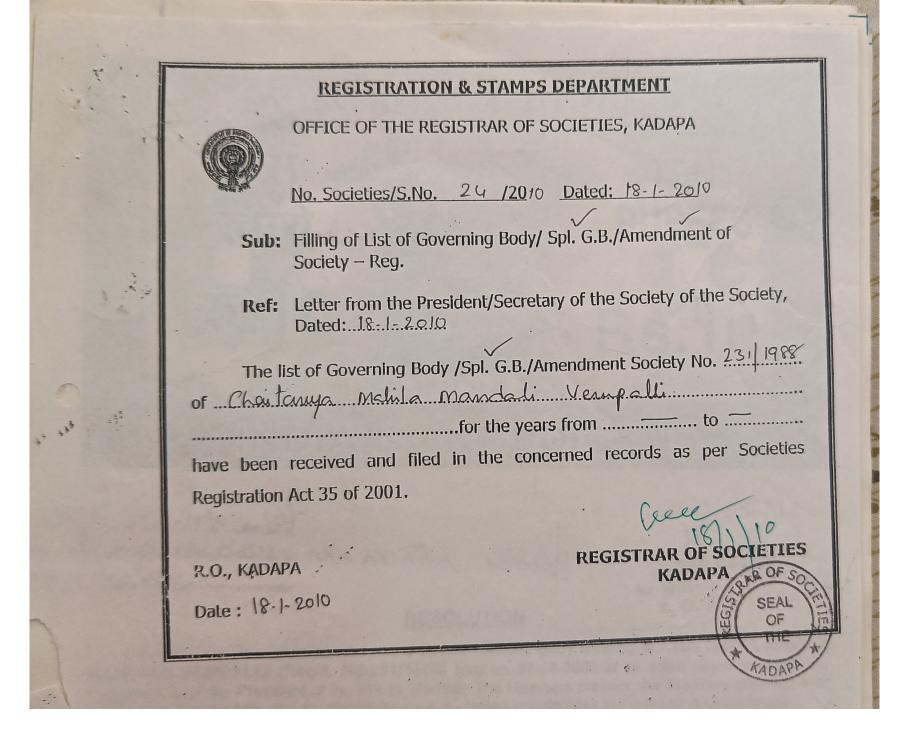

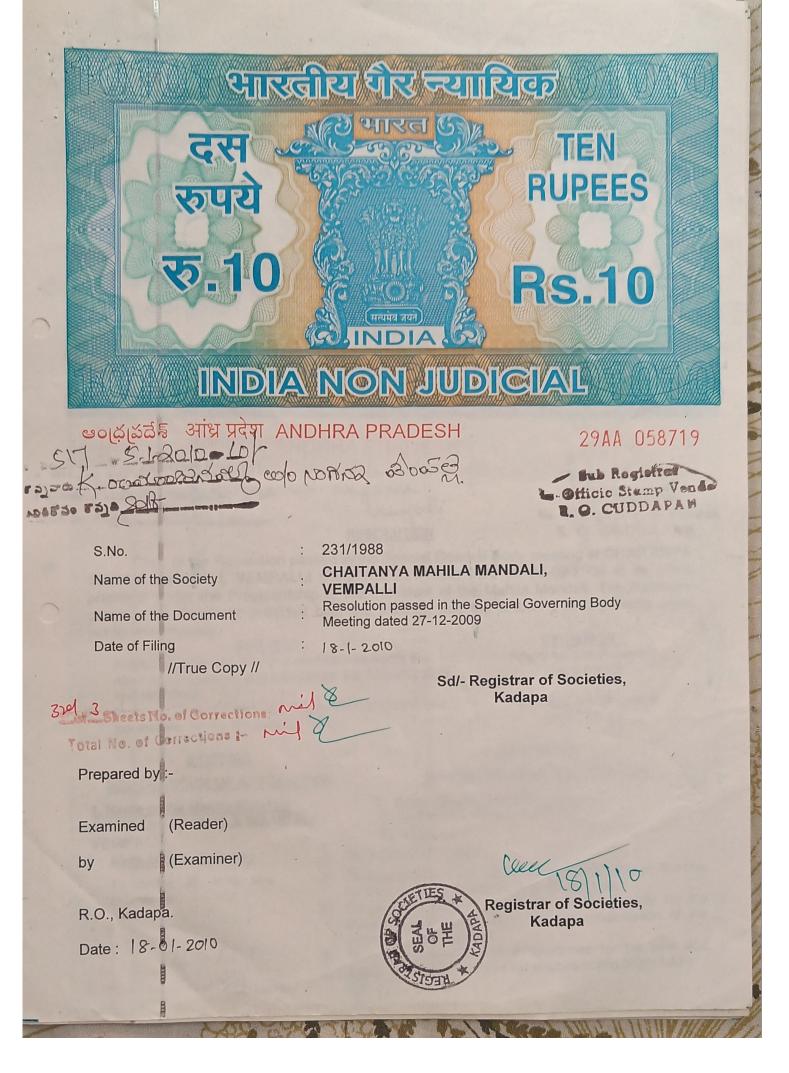
