The Mahila Mandali was registered under the Societies Registration Act XXI 1860 on 27-06-1988 bearing Regd. No. 231/1988 and also registered under Foreign Contribution (Regulation) Act, 2010 and obtained the FCRA Registration No. 010160236, which was renewed on 06-07-2023 with validity from 01-10-2023 to 30-09-2028. The Mahila Mandali was also registered under NGO DARPAN with Unique ID: AP/2018/0218535. It has its General Body members from various communities having great enthusiasm, zeal and zest to work for the downtrodden. The President of the Mahila Mandali is an experienced, educated, cultured and an eminent person who has dedicated his service for the up-liftment of weaker section and backward communities in all walks of life.

The CMM is rendering service in rural and backward areas. The services of the Mahila Mandali touched the lives in remote and unreached areas of Vempalli Mandal of Y.S.R. Kadapa District subject to stress factors like Health, Education, droughts, women Empowerment, Child Welfare, Youth Welfare, Old Aged People Welfare and other slow calamities related to poverty, in-equality in gender etc., Over the years, the original mandate of alleviating the poverty and enhancing the quality of life of the rural poor people have remained the same.

Through the strategic orientation has undergone change to meet the challenges of today keeping in view the needs of tomorrow. The Trust has expanded its understanding of rural realities on addressing poverty holistically, especially its roots in societal discrimination. The Mahila Mandali will be ever grateful to the native people of those grass roots for our sincere efforts to their active incredible participation.

ACTIVITIES IMPLEMENTED DURING THE YEAR 2022-23

GRANTS

PROVISION OF SAFE & CLEAN DRINKING WATER TO THE MARGINALIZED PEOPLE IN THE REMOTE WATER SCARCITY VILLAGE.

We all need clean water, water that is free of potentially dangerous contaminants, which can be used for drinking, cooking, cleaning and bathing. The CMM implemented the Provision of Safe & Clean Drinking Water to the Marginalized People in the Remote Water Scarcity Village in 01 village of Vempalli Mnadal of Y.S.R. Kadapa District. Nearly 200 families are now able to have clean drinking water sufficiently. All the benefited families expressed their whole hearted regards and gratitude towards CMM and the Donor. This programme was financially supported by THE GUIRDHAM TRUST FOR INDIA, UNITED KINGDOM, for installation of 01 Drinking Water Bore Well along with HandPump. The CMM also conducted Health and Hygiene Awareness Generation Camps in this village.

DISTRIBUTION OF STUDY MATERIALS FOR POOR STUDENTS:

THE SHAMDASANI FOUNDATION CHARITABLE TRUST, Hong Kong, has provided grant- in-aid to purchased Examination Pas, Question Banks books, pens, pencils and other study materials for 160 poor dissevering school going children of M.P.P.E. School, Vempalli, Vempalli Mandal of Y.S.R. Kadapa District. Resource persons from local education department, village elders and the CMM members were participated in this programme and motivated the parents regarding the importance of education to their children. "CMM" sole aim is to provide equal opportunities for quality education to deserving students. Those who want to study should never have to give it up because of lack of resources."

FORMATION OF SELF HELP GROUPS:

The CMM with definite group concept, formed Self Help Groups with the rural women. The Mahila Mandali formed nearly 60 groups in the area of operation. With the help of the Mahila Mandali, the beneficiaries are producing the coconut mats, bamboo baskets, plastic baskets, soft toys etc., and earning additional income to their families. The beneficiaries are developing their life standards, economic and social sustainability as SHG members.

WOMEN DEVELOPMENT PROGRAMMES:





The CMM organised Women Empowerment Progamme in 04 Villages of Vempalli Mandal of Y.S.R. Kadapa District to create socio-economic awareness among the rural poor. The camps were aimed at for better environment management permitting sustainable development, conservation of natural resources and restoration and improvement of environmental quality, while permitting sustainable development. The Mahila Mandali has motivated 445 people from the rural areas of Vempalli Mandal of Y.S.R. Kadapa District. We have discussed the importance of reconciling the conservation of biodiversity; social development and maintenance of associated cultural values, conservation and management of dry and barren lands.

MID DAY MEAL PROGRAMME:





The "CMM" implementing Mid Day Meal programmes for the poor children of M.P.P. Elementary School, Harijanawada, Vempalli, of Y.S.R. Kadapa District. Under Andhra Pradesh State Mid Day Meal Scheme the mahila mandali supplied nutritional food to children in the age group of 06-10 years. Nearly 84 children were benefited under this programme. We supplied Rice, Eggs with appropriate soft curry.

VOCATIONAL TRAININGS ON TAILORING:









The CMM is regularly implementing the Tailoring Training for the needy poor women of Vempalli mandal of Y.S.R. Kadapa District. The manual handling sewing machines are provided to the beneficiaries along with the tools, implements and raw material. An experienced sewing instructress was appointed to impart the skill development training to them. The Training on Stitching and Embroidery were been given to the trainees. Till date 50 students passed in tailoring and embroidery training and the certificates were issued from this tailoring training centre. At least half of them are earning their livelihood through tailoring.

SWATCHA BHARATH PROGRAMME:

The CMM is implementing the Swatcha Bharath Programme in rural and slum areas of Vempalli of Vempalli Mandals of Y.S.R. Kadapa District. Under Swatcha Bharat Mission the CMM has aware the rural people on emphasizing on the proper disposal of garbage, dustbin installation, eradicating open defecation habit, renovation of abandoned community toilets and constructing new community toilets and Individual Household Latrine where ever requires in rural as well as urban areas. However, the CMM team is committed to overcome the challenges and increase sanitation density.

MAINTENANCE OF OLD AGE HOME:









There are number of old age poor people's in every villages, some are living with one meal and some of them living without wife without husband, without children and some of them Living terminated by their children and daughter in laws and son in law's. The poor people don't even get food, cloth and shelter which are the basic needs of any human being.

In this regard our Mahila Mandali is running the old age home at Vempalli Town of Vemaplli Mandal of Y.S.R. Kadapa District. In this home we are providing shelter, Nutrition food, Medical Support, Recreation for 30 poor and deserving old aged men and women of age round about 60-70. We have collected donations from likeminded people to meet the expenditure towards purchase of Rice, Provisions, Vegetables, Milk, Eggs, etc.,

Thus the "CMM" is continuously undertaking many progressive activities which are useful and benefitable for the poor and needy in the rural area for the betterment of downtrodden people.
